Current WWL President and 4-year member, Tammy Roberts, said, "The League acts as a life-line to the community and I'm proud to take the helm this year as we continue our philanthropic ventures." General membership meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month and the volunteer projects are many and varied. The League's enrollment is ongoing and members must be 21 to join. The organization is diverse, as it is comprised of single and married women, the working and stay-at-home sets, as well as those whose children are grown. "Collectively, the group is a volunteer powerhouse from which lasting friendships have sprung," added Roberts.

This year's luncheon will be held at the home of Jackie Kupper at 11:00 am, 51 West Branch Road, Weston – a scenic setting on shore of the Saugatuck River. Admission is free.
